302 is not murder, 420 not cheating: Proposed Code

Govt tables Bill to replace colonial-era laws; death for lynching and rape of minors

New Delhi, 11 August

If a Bill that Home Minister Amit Shah introduced in the Lok Sabha on Friday becomes the law of the land, Indian Penal Code (IPC) Section 302 would no longer prescribe the punishment for murder. It would instead relate to the crime of snatching in the proposed Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita (BNS). The BNS has no Section 420 of the IPC, which relates to the offence of cheating, and covers it its Section 316.

On Friday, the concluding day of the monsoon session, Shah introduced three Bills in the Lok Sabha to replace colonial-era laws. He said it would overhaul the criminal justice system, end delays, and ensure justice in a maximum of three years. He introduced the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita (BNS) Bill, 2023; Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita (BNSS) Bill, 2023; and Bharatiya Sakshya (BS) Bill, 2023 that will replace the Indian Penal Code (IPC), 1860, Criminal Procedure Act (CrPC), 1898, and the Indian Evidence Act, 1872 respectively.

The Opposition criticised the new Bills. The Congress said it was part of the bigger design of Prime Minister Narendra Modi to leave his imprint on everything and that for Modi, everything in the past, whether social, legal, cultural or political, was terrible and needed overhauling. The ruling Dravida Munnetra Kazhagam (DMK) in Tamil Nadu termed it "Hindi imposition" and an "audacious attempt" to tamper with India's diversity. In recent years, the other Bills with Hindi names are the Direct Tax Vivad Se Vishwas Bill of March 2020 and the Jan Vishwas Bill.

The BNS Bill provides maximum capital punishment for crimes such as mob lynching and rape of minors, the home minister said. The Bill also has provisions to provide community service as one of the punishments for first-time petty offences.

However, while it deletes Section 124 A of the IPC, which deals with sedition, the BNS has Section 150 that lists new offences such as acts of secession, armed rebellion, subversive activities, separatist activities or

endangering the sovereignty or unity and integrity of India. The sedition law, known as 'Raidroh' has got a new term for it, 'Deshdroh', thus doing away with the reference to the British crown, officials said. Section 124 in the BNS relates to the crime of wrongful restraint.

In a post on X (previously Twitter), advocate Prashant Bhusan said: "Three hugely important laws which will affect all of us are introduced at the end of this session without any disclosure of discussion. The colonial wolf of sedition brought back in sheep's clothing."

Shah requested Lok Sabha Speaker Om Birla to refer the three Bills for examination by the Parliamentary Standing Committee on Home Affairs. Under the new laws, the charge sheet must be filed within 90 days, and the court can give permission for another 90 days to look at the situation. The probe would have to be finished in 180 days and sent for trial. After trial, judgment will have to be given in 30 days.

Sexual exploitation of women on the pretext of marriage, job, promotions, or by hiding identity will be considered a crime and attract up to 10-year imprisonment. The provision could cover cases of interfaith marriages under false names. For gang rape, there is a provision for punishment of 20 years imprisonment or life imprisonment, while there is a provision for a death sentence in case of rape with a minor. Community service is being introduced as a punishment for the first time.

Terrorism has been defined under the law for the first time, the minister said. There is also a provision for attaching the property of the terrorist. To stop political use of punishment waivers by governments, a new provision has been made that death sentences can only be converted to life imprisonment and life imprisonment be pardoned only within seven years of punishment.

Shah referred to the recent release of criminal-politician Anand Mohan in Bihar and said the provision had been made to ensure that those with political influence do not escape law.

₹6,000 crore set aside for land acquisition

Lucknow, 11 August

In a move to boost planned industrialisation and urbanisation, the Uttar Pradesh government has earmarked nearly ₹6,000 crore for land acquisition across the state.

The amount would be spent on purchasing land parcels from farmers and landowners in the arid Bundelkhand region. New townships in seven towns—Gorakhpur, Bareilly, Bulandshahr, Agra, Aligarh, Jhansi and Chitrakoot—will also be acquired.

The major chunk of ₹5,000 crore would be spent on Bundelkhand land by the proposed Bundelkhand Industrial Development Authority (BIDA), the remaining portion of ₹1,000 crore would be incurred on new townships.

The acquisition is in addition to similar measures being taken by other industrial development authorities and the housing board in other districts, a senior official said.

Meanwhile, UP industrial development minister Nand Gopal Gupta Nandi said that the government was toeing the line of 'reform-perform-transform' to change the development landscape of the state.

"The state had netted more than 1,000 investment proposals worth ₹3.75 trillion for Bundelkhand region at the UP Global Investors Summit 2023 in February. To accelerate the development journey in the region, the BIDA blueprint has been drawn

up," he added.

A recent UP cabinet meeting had cleared the proposal of injecting ₹8,000 crore in different industrial development authorities, of which the maximum ₹5,000 crore would be pumped in for BIDA alone.

An additional ₹1,000 crore has been allocated for new townships, of which Gorakhpur would receive the maximum ₹400 crore for land acquisition, followed by Agra and Aligarh at ₹150 crore each.

The Yogi government is planning to develop 100 new townships with the help of private investors to boost economic development and create jobs.

Earlier this year, the state claimed to have received proposals from almost 450 private investors for the ambitious new townships roadmap.

The new townships would be developed in the periphery of big cities to decongest urban centres and synergise development, economic activities, housing, and job market.

Besides, the state is in the process of rationalising building bylaws to facilitate higher vertical real estate growth.

At the same time, the private investment proposals in the pipeline entail acquisition of about 1,500 acres of land for setting up industrial units across 75 districts.

UP chief minister Yogi Adityanath has instructed UP industrial development authorities to ensure that land acquisition process was completed in a seamless manner.

MADHYA PRADESH

Women to handle toll booth ops

To empower women of the state, the Madhya Pradesh government has decided that women will now handle the operation of toll booths with a turnover of up to ₹2 crore annually. Chief Minister Shivraj Singh Chouhan reiterated this decision in a program organized in Anuppur district.

Recently, the Council of Ministers approved the policy for collection of consumer charges at toll booths by women self-help groups.

According to the decision, consumer fee collection will be done by women self-help groups on routes with annual collection income of less than ₹2 crore. Madhya Pradesh Road Development Corporation has been authorized to select such routes.

CM Chouhan has frequently said that Madhya Pradesh is one of the leading states in the field of planning and implementing schemes for women empowerment.

State woos tourists with new products

After seeing a surge in tourist arrivals, the Rajasthan government has decided to offer new tourism products, such as crafts and cuisine tourism, to woo more visitors to the state.

"Many innovative steps are being taken by the government to give tourists more choices to enjoy the state," a tourism department official said.

Talking about one such step, the official added that the crafts and cuisine tourism will not only boost tourism but also help sustain livelihoods by generating self-employment.

He said that a rich tradition of handicrafts will be promoted in the state. And, direct marketing platforms will be provided on the lines of Delhi Haat

These platforms will be available in Jaipur, Jodhpur, Udaipur, and Bikaner with

the help of the department of industries.

Moreover, showcasing of dying crafts will be undertaken through the Virasat Museum, Jaipur, and all state museums under the art and culture department.

There is also a plan to promote Rajasthan cuisine through food festivals and by developing gourmet cuisine trails.

The official added that experiments such as Masala Chowk, Jaipur, will be repli-

cated in other cities of the state.

According to the tourism department, in 2022, over 100 million domestic tourists visited the state.

The tourism department is also creating new tourist circuits in the state.

The state has also seen a surge in religious tourism in recent years. In view of this, the state government will spend over ₹24 crore to give a fillip to religious tourism.

- The above unaudited financial results of the Company for the quarter ended June 30, 2023 have been reviewed by the Audit Committee and approved by the Board of Directors at their respective meetings held on August 11, 2023. These results have been subjected to limited review by the statutory auditors of the Company.
- These unaudited financial results have been prepared in accordance with recognition and measurement principles laid down in the Indian Accounting Standard 34 "Interim Financial Reporting" ("Ind AS 34"), prescribed under Section 133 of the Companies Act, 2013 read with the relevant rules issued thereunder and other accounting principles generally accepted in India.
- Figures for the quarter ended March 31, 2023 represents the difference between the audited figures in respect of full financial year and the unaudited published figures of nine months ended December 31, 2022 which have been subjected to limited review by the statutory auditors.
- The Board of Directors at its meeting held on May 5 2023, approved a draft Scheme of Amalgamation by way of merger by absorption ("Scheme") between TCNS Clothing Co. Limited (Transferor Company) and Aditya Birla Fashion and Retail Limited (Transferee Company) and their respective shareholders and creditors, under Sections 230 to 232 of the Companies Act, 2013. The Amalgamation is conditional upon and subject to Transferor Company and Transferee Company complying with the 'Conditions Precedent to Effectiveness' as stated in clause 31 of the Scheme and receipt of requisite approvals from Statutory and Regulatory authorities, the respective shareholders and creditors, under applicable laws. On the scheme becoming effective, 11 fully paid-up equity shares of the face value of Rs. 10 of Transferee Company will be issued for every 6 fully paid-up equity shares of the face value of Rs. 2 of the Transferor Company.
- During the quarter ended March 31, 2023, the Company had renewed certain leases effective from earlier quarters and accordingly accounted for these leases from the effective date. This had resulted in increase in finance costs and depreciation and amortisation expense by Rs. 11.33 million and Rs. 30.16 million respectively with a corresponding decrease in other expenses by Rs. 33.23 million during the quarter ended March 31, 2023.
- The Company has allotted 1,437,250 equity shares during the quarter ended June 30, 2023 respectively of face value of Rs. 2 per share arising from exercise of Employee stock options plans (ESOPs), which were granted under 'TCNS ESOP Scheme 2014-2017'.
- The Company is primarily engaged in the business of women apparel and accessories in India. Accordingly, the Company views its business activities as one business segment, therefore there are no separate reportable segments as per Indian Accounting Standard (Ind AS) 108 - "Operating Segments".
